LEVEL I WATER EMERGENCY: The water emergency is over effective December 1. Thank you for conservation efforts during this summer's water shortage!

2009 INCOME AND EXPENDITURES: The District has a projected \$36,000 operating loss (operating deficit) for the year. This deficit eliminated the banked funds that have been used over the past several years to fund operating expenses.

OPERATOR IN RESPONSIBLE CHARGE: Beginning December 5, John Clawson, the District's O.R.C. has taken a medical leave of absence. Until his return, Pitt Constriction will be maintaining the distribution system. Continue to call 872-8017 to report breaks or needed repairs.

FEES: Certified Letters: Effective January 1, 2010, when it is necessary to send a Certified Letter to a tap holder for non-compliance with the District's Rules and Regulations, a \$30 fee will be accessed to the tap holder for the time and cost of processing.

WORKING WATER LINES? Call 872-8017 and request a line locator. If you do not call and your digging results in a line break, you will be assessed a minimum of \$300 plus the expenses to repair the break.

FUNDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS: The District is seeking a volunteer with experience in grant writing. The District will be applying for federal and/or state funding to increase our water storage capacity, secure our water source, and replace sections of deteriorating pipeline.
